

# Shipment order

A shipment order is an order to a warehouse inside the digital to ship something to a location.

A shipping order can be created for many reasons:

- for the direct fulfillment of an order ([customer order](#), [internal order](#))
- for the indirect fulfillment of any order type through a process step along a [fulfillment supply chain](#)
- for an inter-warehouse internal relocation
- for an internal relocation for material required for a [production order](#)
