

Shipment path

A shipment path is the concrete combination of a [delivery services provider](#) and a [delivery service product](#) of this provider. Each digital can individually bind one or multiple [delivery options](#), which are the abstraction level of the shipment path used to sync with partners in the supply chain on the desired form of transportation of [orders](#). Shipment paths are used in [fulfillment plans](#) to define the form and standard duration of shipments.

Example

The shipment path "SWISS POST, A-Post" defines the vendor ("SWISS POST"), the product "A-Post" and the standard delivery time (2 days).
