Shipment path

A shipment path is the concrete combination of a <u>delivery services provider</u> and a <u>delivery service</u> <u>product</u> of this provider. Each digital can individually bind one or mulitple <u>delivery options</u>, which are the abstraction level of the shipment path used to sync with partners in the supply chain on the desired form of transportation of <u>orders</u>. Shipment paths are used in <u>fulfillment plans</u> to define the form and standard duration of shipments.

Example

The shipment path "SWISS POST, A-Post" defines the vendor ("SWISS POST"), the product "A-Post" and the standard delivery time (2 days).

Administration

Shipment paths are administered in the shipment path administration app.
